



Vendor Guidelines and Information

Rules

- No open flames, incense, smoking, bubble machines, etc. This is for fire safety, and prevention of damage to art works.
- Electrical cords that are not confined to behind your table must be taped to the floor (on carpeted areas) or covered with rubber-backed mat or rug (on wood floors).
- Bring your own table linens, even if renting tables.
- Rental tables are 4 ft. each in length.
- Do not block view of artwork.
- Do not touch, move or remove artwork. If you need to adjust any displays, please ask us to help.
- Gift shop will be open, but does not handle Meraki fair transactions. Bring your own credit card device and cash box, as well as cash to make change.
- Snacks and coffee/tea will be provided for VENDORS ONLY. These will be in the gallery kitchen
- Parking is available on the east side of the building all day on Saturday and Sunday and is free.
- Two parking spaces on the west side of the building are reserved for loading and unloading.
